Top Tips for Mastering Sight Words

Heidi will share what she does in her K classroom to help her students reach mastery of the sight words, in addition to using the sight word songs. What are the daily and weekly lessons that seem to make the most difference in student achievement? MOST of them are done in a whole group setting. Find out how at least 90% of Heidi's students, most of whom come from low income backgrounds, usually master 90-100% of the 50 required district sight words and then some!
